

It's almost foaling season! It is time to prepare those broodmares and update show horse vaccines for the year.

- Remember Pre-Foaling vaccines 30 days prior to foaling in order to ensure proper transfer of antibodies to the foals
- Remember to check **foals IgG** levels at approximately 24 hours in order to ensure adequate colostrums consumption.
 - o If foals do not receive the necessary colostrums, they will be susceptible to any and all types of infection found in their environment.
 - o Consider Plasma Administration should it be needed, it is a great immune booster
- Broodmares: Pre-foaling shots (30 days prior to foaling)
 - o Presitge V+WN and Rabies
- **Foals:** If the mare DID NOT get her pre-foaling tetanus (included in the Prestige 6 way), then the foal needs to be given a Tetanus Antitoxin SQ at birth
- Foals at 5 Months: should be given their first set of vaccines
 - o Prestige V+WN (6 Way) & Rabies
- Foals at 6 months: Booster their 1st set of
 - o Prestige V+WN (6way) & Rabies
- Strangles (Strep) vaccine is optional. Some ranches have an endemic problem. It is not however recommended to give foals younger than 5 months this vaccine.

And just a reminder on those show horses:

- Spring: Prestige V+WN (6 Way) & Rabies
- Fall: Flu/Rhino
