



FALL FUTURITIES = FALL INFLUENZA SEASON

This is a reminder to make sure that you have all of your horses and client horses up to date on their Respiratory Vaccines before heading down the road to your next show!

By making sure that you have these Respiratory Vaccines (Flu, Rhino), you will help to prevent the “down time” caused by many of the respiratory illnesses & side effects such as: fevers, coughing, nasal discharge, swollen lymph nodes, depression, loss of appetite, etc.

Not only will vaccinating help prevent your show horses from contracting these viruses, but it will also help ensure you don’t bring one of these viruses home from a show and contaminate the rest of your barn.

The fall season is also a reminder of weaning your foals and vaccinating them for the first time. The vaccinations that they get will depend on if the mare was vaccinated with her Pre-Foaling Shots.

We here at Independence Equine, have compiled a simple list to help you know what to vaccinate for this Fall Season:

ADULT SHOW HORSES:

FLU/RHINO:

Flu: Influenza Nasal
Prodigy Rhino: **2cc Dose**

PREGNANT MARES:

5, 7, 9 Months:
Prodigy Rhino: 2cc

FOALS: VACCINATED MARES:

4 MONTHS:

- Prestige V+WN:
(6 Way-Flu/Rhino/EWT/WN)
- Rabies

5 MONTHS: BOOSTER:

- Prestige V+WN: (6 way)
- Rabies

FOALS: UN-VACCINATED MARE

AT BIRTH:

Tetanus Anti-Toxin
4 Months: Prestige V+WN:
(6 way) & Rabies

5 MONTHS: Boosters:
Flu/Rhino & Rabies
